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<u>Selection Criteria for Maroubra Junction Public School</u> <u>Annual Sports Boy and Sports Girl Champion Award</u>

The Maroubra Junction Public School (MJPS) Annual Sports Boy and Sports Girl champion award is based on a student's selection to zone, regional, state and/or national level in either swimming, athletics or cross country as well as sports that are endorsed by the Department of Education and Communities (DEC) and the Eastern Suburbs Primary Schools Sports Association (ESPSSA) which is part of the Sydney East School Sports Association (SESSA). Students who are successful in obtaining a place in a married team, that is Eastern Suburbs and Sydney Coastal teams join together to make a zone team, would be considered as competing at a zone level.

Points will be attributed to students according to their highest level of achievement in particular sports.

Selection to the team/carnival will obtain:

- Selection in a *School team* to compete at a *zone* competition/carnival = 3 points (delete)
- Selection in a Zone team to compete at a Sydney East carnival/championship = 5 points (change to 3 points)
- Selection in a *Married team* to compete at a *Sydney East* carnival/championship = 6 points (change to 4 points)
- Selection in a Sydney East team to compete at a NSW carnival/championship = 7 points (stay at 7 points)
- Selection in a NSW team to compete at a NATIONAL carnival/championship = 10 points (stay at 10 points)

Where there is a tie, both students will be awarded the Sports boy or Sports Girl Champion Award.
